The origin and meaning of "Shaddai" are obscure, and a variety of hypotheses have been put forward, and no one agrees with any one definition. Scholar Ernst Knauf suggested a meaning that I like, that "EI Shaddai" means "God of the Wilderness" and originally would not have had a doubled "d". In this theory, the word is related to the Hebrew word "sade" meaning "the (uncultivated) field", the area of hunting.

#### **Old Business**

The changes to the boundaries of the Parsonage and the Tverberg Cabin are being undertaken.

- Discussion was held as to the inspection of the parsonage and possible asbestos removal. The possibility of the Parsonage Committee paying was suggested. It was moved, seconded, and approved that the removal of the Parsonage required further discussion at the Joint Meeting in June.
